

1. Online library services

The Klebelsberg Library makes registration easier and more convenient for **University of Szeged students** with an electronic registration form. During their university studies, students are expected to accept the conditions of the electronic library membership declaration once in the MODULO system.

As the last step of the process cannot be carried out in person, the process has been automated to ensure access to our e-resources. However, everyone who registers during this period is requested to go to the library's loan section once in person following reopening to verify their personal data.

Registration will be confirmed at 9 am on the next weekday. The username required for online registration will be your student card number, or, failing that, your Neptun code. Your default password is your date of birth in the following format: DD-MMM-YY, for example, 08-OCT-83 (three-letter abbreviation for the month in caps).

Students who have already submitted the declaration need not follow this procedure again. They can use the e-resources with the ID number on their library card or student card as before.

2. Foreign Language Centre

Language courses have continued uninterrupted at the University of Szeged's language school. Adapting to distance education, teachers hold almost every lesson online at the original time through CooSpace. Students who cannot take part in lessons can still complete their courses by submitting their assignments. Detailed information on the completion of language courses can be found on the CooSpace scene for the particular course.

3. Let's prepare for the examination period!

After 4 May 2020, registration for examinations will begin gradually and will be arranged by the faculties. Therefore, it is advisable that you start to prepare for the examination period, which will begin on 18 May 2020.

In the information letter next week, you will be provided with detailed information on the examination period.

It is important to highlight that, in accordance with Government Decree No. 101/2020. (IV. 10.), there will be no reclassification based on academic performance in the summer of 2020:

"Section 4. With regard to the 2020–21 academic year, no reclassification shall occur as per Act CCIV of 2011 on National Higher Education Section 48/2."

In practice, this means that reclassification from state-funded to self-funded student status based on academic performance is suspended in the 2019–20 academic year. Reclassification from self-funded to state-funded student status remains an option, however.

This does not apply to students who have exhausted the maximum number of state-funded semesters available to them. Those students will be reclassified at the end of the second semester of the 2019–20 academic year.

4. Brainstorming in Munich

The first online **Innovation Days** will be hosted by the Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität, Munich, under the **EUGLOH Project**. This event will provide a forum for the introduction and development of innovative solutions, ideas and prototypes that tackle global health challenges (such as the current Covid-19 pandemic) between 25 and 27 May 2020.

We welcome PhD students who are interested in finding innovative solutions within the 'One Health' health program or who already have a concrete idea on how to tackle global health problems.
